

**2018 NEW ZEALAND NATIONAL RUMMIKUB
CHAMPIONSHIP
CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – GOLDEN JOKER**

1. This competition (“Competition”) is conducted by Sweetpea Marketing Ltd (“Promoter”)
2. The competition is the 2018 New Zealand National Rummikub Championship which is the New Zealand national qualifying tournament for the 2018 “World Rummikub Championships” which is to be conducted by Lemada in Jerusalem, Israel 9th - 12th of November 2018.
3. There are 4 golden jokers to be found around New Zealand. These have been placed in the Rummikub with a Twist game randomly around the country.
4. Simply purchase a Rummikub with a Twist game from any Whitcoulls store or online for your chance to find one of four golden jokers.
5. A golden joker gives you an instant place in the NZ semifinals on the 8th of September 2018 in Auckland venue to be confirmed by the 1st of August 2018, check www.rummikub.co.nz for details.
6. All 4 golden joker winners must make their own way at their own cost to the National Semi Final Competition.
7. If a golden joker winner is not able to attend the semifinals for any reason a new competitive will be selected from either the north or south island national competitions, at the promoters discretion.
8. Entry to the Competition constitutes acceptance to these conditions. All entry instructions and prize information published by the Promoter forms part of these conditions.
9. The Competition is only open to Eligible Entrants. An “Eligible Entrant” is an individual who, at the time of entry is: (i) a resident of New Zealand aged 18 years or older; (ii) is not an employee of the Promoter; (iii) is not a spouse, defacto partner, parent, child or sibling (whether full, half, step or by adoption) of such an employee.

10. All times and dates are times and dates in Auckland, unless they relate to an event taking place elsewhere, in which case they are expressed in local time at that place.
11. When participating in any the National competition, all Participants must comply with the “Rummikub Championship Rules,” as those rules may be amended by the Promoter from time to time (“Rules’). A copy of the Rules is available by clicking the “Rules” link at the Competition Website. In particular, but without limitation, a Participant must attend the venue for any round, at the time and on the date notified to the Participant by the Promoter. The start of any game will not wait on any player.
12. The Promoter reserves the right, in their absolute discretion and without having to give any reason/s, to disqualify any individual that the Promoter believes has provided false information, tampered with the entry process or failed to abide by these Conditions of Entry or Rules.
13. Any Participant in the National Competition is responsible for any and all costs and expenses that they may incur in attending the National Competition (including without limitation all transport, accommodation and other expenses related to such attendance).
14. The Promoter reserves the right to include wildcard entry(s) at the National Competition event.
