

**2018 NEW ZEALAND NATIONAL RUMMIKUB
CHAMPIONSHIP
CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - PARTICIPATION**

1. This competition (“Competition”) is conducted by Sweetpea Marketing Ltd (“Promoter”)
2. The competition is the 2018 New Zealand National Rummikub Championship which is the New Zealand national qualifying tournament for the 2018 “World Rummikub Championships” which is to be conducted by Lemada in Jerusalem, Israel 9th - 12th of November 2018.
3. The competition has three stages:
 - (i) The first stage comprises of 80 participants being selected through online entries to compete in the National competition. Entries open the 18th July 2018. Entries close 19th of August for South Island and 26th August for North Island
 - (ii) The second stage is the two National competitions (“National Final Round”) consisting of 40 participants for each competition, which will be held in Christchurch at Northlands Mall on the 25th August 2018 and Auckland at Sylvia Park on the 1st September 2018
 - (iii) The third stage is the Final Competition, consisting of the top 4 players from both the North and South Island Competitions and the 4 golden joker winners. This is to be held in Auckland on the 8th of September 2018, venue will be confirmed by the 1st of August 2018, check www.rummikub.co.nz for further details.
4. All 80 competitors for the North & South Island National competition must make their own way at their own cost to the National competition.

5. All 12 competitors (top four from North and & South Island National Comps and the four golden joker winners) must make their own way at their own cost to the National Final Competition in Auckland on the 8th of September 2018, venue will be confirmed by the 1st of August 2018, check www.rummikub.co.nz for further details. The winner of the Winner of the NZ Finals will win a prize entitling them to participate in the World Rummikub Championship (“National Prize). Prize includes certain travel and accommodation and is described in further detail below.
6. Entry to the Competition constitutes acceptance to these conditions. All entry instructions and prize information published by the Promoter forms part of these conditions.
7. The Competition is only open to Eligible Entrants. An “Eligible Entrant” is an individual who, at the time of entry is: (i) a resident of New Zealand aged 18 years or older; (ii) is not an employee of the Promoter; (iii) is not a spouse, defacto partner, parent, child or sibling (whether full, half, step or by adoption) of such an employee.
8. All times and dates are times and dates in Auckland, unless they relate to an event taking place elsewhere, in which case they are expressed in local time at that place.

ENTRY

9. An Eligible Entrant may not participate in this Competition unless they are invited to do so by the Promoter. Eligible Entrants may request an invitation to enter the Competition by using a compatible web browser to visit ww.rummikub.co.nz (“Competition Website”) and following the instructions listed. The Promoter has unlimited discretion as to whom it invites to enter the Competition, and no obligation to give any reasons for its decisions, but will give some weight to the knowledge demonstrated by any entry made in the “ Your top Rummikub Story that brought people together” box on the web site registration page.

10. The Promoter will invite a maximum of 84 Eligible Entrants to participate in the National Competition 80 (40 per national competition), of whom will be entitled to be at a Competition table seat (made of 5 tables of four per round) and 4 of whom will be substitutes (per national competition). Substitutes may be allocated a Competition table seat at the discretion of the Promoter. Accordingly, there will be a total of 84 Eligible Entrants ("Participants"), inclusive of substitutes, who will be invited to participate in the National Competition.
11. The confirmation of Participants will take place no later than 19th of August 2018 for the South Island and 26th of August for the North Island. Participants will be contacted via the email address supplied by the Participant when requesting an invitation at the Competition Website.
12. When participating in any the National competition, all Participants must comply with the "Rummikub Championship Rules," as those rules may be amended by the Promoter from time to time ("Rules"). A copy of the Rules is available by clicking the "Rules" link at the Competition Website. In particular, but without limitation, a Participant must attend the venue for any round, at the time and on the date notified to the Participant by the Promoter. The start of any game will not wait on any player.
13. The Promoter reserves the right, in their absolute discretion and without having to give any reason/s, to disqualify any individual that the Promoter believes has provided false information, tampered with the entry process or failed to abide by these Conditions of Entry or Rules.
14. Any Participant in the National Competition is responsible for any and all costs and expenses that they may incur in attending the National Competition (including without limitation all transport, accommodation and other expenses related to such attendance).
15. The Promoter reserves the right to include wildcard entry(s) at the National Competition event.

16. The winner of the National Final Round will be determined in accordance with the Rules. The winner will win the National Prize comprising for its winner and, subject to these conditions;

- (i) Return economy flights to Jerusalem, Israel from an international airport (to be) designated by the Promoter;
- (ii) Three night's accommodation at the exquisite Waldorf Astoria Jerusalem.
- (iii) All meals throughout the whole event.
- (iv) The right to participate in the World Rummikub Championships at a location in or near Jerusalem, Israel 9th - 12th of November 2018.

17. The National Prize will be arranged by the Promoter on dates to coincide with the World Rummikub Championships

18. All aspects of the National Prize (including travel and accommodation) are for the winner only.

19. Changes to travel or accommodation arrangements are at the expense of the National Prize winner.

20. All components of the National Prize must be taken together as a single trip to be booked by the Promoter. Any part of the National Prize that is not taken for any reason is forfeited.

21. The National Prize does not (except as expressly stated) include:

- (i) Any transport between a traveller's residence and the departure airport;
- (ii) Any overnight accommodation while traveling to the departure airport;
- (iii) Any other travel or accommodation;
- (iv) Any incidental hotel charges (such as mini-bar charges, telephone calls, in house movies, food and beverages);
- (v) Any spending money
- (vi) Any insurance (such as travel or health cover);

- (vii) Any costs associated with any passport, visa, health or other requirements for entry into any foreign country and return to New Zealand;
- (viii) Any vaccinations or other medical or health related services;
- (ix) Any other ancillary costs which may be incurred by the winner in relation to the National Prize.

22. The National Prize cannot be exchanged for other travel or accommodation at other destinations.

23. The winner of the National Prize is responsible for compliance with any health, passport, visa and other requirements for entry into any country en-route, for the final destination and return to New Zealand and shall bear all risks associated with any refusal of entry into any country. No compensation will be payable if the winner is unable to use the National Prize (or any part of it) as stated for whatever reason.

WINNER

24. In order to be entitled to any prize, each winner must, if requested by the Promoter, agree to and sign:

- (i) Any eligibility form confirming their compliance with the Conditions of Entry and eligibility to accept the prize; and
- (ii) A liability release in favor of the Promoter and/or any person or other entity associated with this Competition.

All winners of the National Finals will be required to participate in PR activities as advised, without requesting or receiving any payment or other valuable consideration, in addition to the winner's prize.

GENERAL

25. The Promoter will supply all game elements and parts used during the National Championships. It is forbidden for players to use their own equipment.

26. If a prize is unavailable for any reason, the Promoter will, in its absolute discretion, substitute alternative goods or services of no lesser retail value and/or specification. The Promoter accepts no other liability or responsibility for any loss incurred by a winner or any other person if a prize (or part of a prize) is unavailable for any reason.
27. If an entrant does not provide accurate personal information the Promoter may determine that they are not eligible to win a prize.
28. A right to receive a prize is not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as a monetary payment.
29. If for any reason the conduct or operation of the Competition is interfered with or disrupted in any way (including by vandalism, power failures, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strikes, computer bugs or viruses, tampering or technical failures), the Promoter reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend or recommence the Competition.
30. The Promoter neither assumes nor accepts responsibility for:
- (i) Any error, omission, interruption, or delay in the operation or transmission of any communication sent to (or by) the Promoter or any entrant whether caused by problems with communication networks or lines, computer systems, software or Internet service providers, congestion on any carrier network or otherwise,
 - (ii) Any theft, destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of such communications;
 - (iii) Any problem with, or technical malfunction of, any computer system or other equipment used for the conduct of the Competition.
31. All of the Promoter's decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
32. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Promoter, its associated companies and agencies and all those entities' personnel (the "Relevant parties") exclude all liability for any loss (including any damage, claim,

injury, cost or expense) which is suffered or incurred by any Eligible Entrant.

33. Each winner consents to the Promoter using their name, likeness, image and/or voice (including any photograph, film and/or recording of them) in any media at any time or times without remuneration for the purpose of promoting the Competition, the Promoter and/or any of the Promoter's products.
34. Eligible Entrants' personal information will be collected by or on behalf of the Promoter to enable it to administer the Competition and publicise its winner(s) and, if such entrant consents, may be used to market products to the entrant. The personal information of each winner may be provided to others assisting in the conduct of the Competition, including the Competition administrator, prize suppliers and deliverers.
